

Foaling Kit

Preparing a foaling kit at least 2 weeks prior to the due date is strongly recommended so that you are prepared.

Some ideas for your kit are as follows:

- □ Tail wrap
- A small bucket for warm water
- A bottle of Hibiscrub to clean the mare's vulva post-foaling, and to disinfect your hands and arms afterwards
- □ A couple clean face cloths
- □ Iodine spray to put on the umbilical stump
- An enema to give to foal after birth if needed to help to get rid of the meconium (first stool)
- □ Clean towels to dry off the foal
- Scissors to cut placenta in case of emergency
